

Stockinette Stitch Triangles Blanket or Shawl

This is basically triangles knit together to resemble a miter.



First Triangle: Cast on 2 stitches. *Knit one row; pull one needle into work on carriage side.* Repeat ** until it's wide enough. On the bulky, I had 89 total stitches, 88 rows of knitting. Bind off. (Bind off used on the pot holder is below.)

Second Triangle: Hang the two cast on stitches of the first triangle on the center 2 needles. *Knit one row; pull one needle into work on carriage side.* Repeat ** until it's the same width/rows as the first triangle. Bind off.

Third Triangle: If you want to have the purl side be the right side of the third triangle (and fourth triangle if you're making a blanket), hold the first and second triangle pieces with the knit side facing you and hang one cast on stitch from each on the center two stitches. If you want to have the knit side be the right side of the third triangle (and fourth triangle if you're making a blanket), hold the first and second triangle pieces with the purl side facing you and hang one cast on stitch from each of the first two triangle pieces on the center two stitches.

***Knit one row; pull the edge stitch out to be sure it knits. Pull one needle into work on carriage side and put a loop from the edge of the previously knit triangle onto it.* Repeat ** until it's the same width as the first two triangles. Bind off.**

If you're making a shawl, you can relax--you're done! It could be tied in front or pinned like Ann was doing.

Fourth Triangle: Make just like the third triangle, remembering to check whether you want purl side or knit side of the already-knit triangles facing you.

Garter Bar Eyelet No-Roll Bind Off

Joni's machine knit version of theheddlework's Lemon, Lime, Orange trim on Ravelry:

Row 1 -- Remembering to hold the garter bar so ridge is up, turn the knitting so knit side faces you, hang knitting on machine and knit one row.

Row 2 -- Remembering to hold the garter bar so ridge is up, turn the knitting so purl side faces you, hang knitting on machine and knit one row.

Row 3 -- Knit.

Row 4 -- Move every other stitch to the next needle to make a lace row. Knit across.

Row 5 -- Knit.

Finish by latch tool bind off. (The combination of knitting a row after the lace row with the latch tool bind off matches the look of rows 1 and 2.)
